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Prior to your departure

By this time, you'll be in contact with Javi, who will arrange everything and stay in touch with you throughout the process.

Your flight:

We recommend booking a flight that arrives at Cancun International Airport.

Cancun International Airport is the second busiest airport in Mexico, making it easy to find convenient connections from almost anywhere in the world.

Mérida International Airport is also a good option.

We also recommend arriving before 4:00 PM, as the drive to Mena Fly Fishing takes around 3.5 hours. This gives us enough time to welcome you properly, enjoy dinner together, and prepare for your first day of fishing.

Transportation to Mena Fly Fishing

Javi will ask for your flight information and track any delays, so your driver will be waiting for you at the airport with a sign displaying your name when you arrive.

The drive takes around 3.5 hours. The vehicle is air-conditioned and comfortable, but we can always stop for a snack, coffee, or a short break. You're already part of the family!

The day starts at 4:50 AM with breakfast. Then we'll head out on the boat with one of our professional guides.

The ride to the tarpon fishing spots usually takes just 5 to 10 minutes.

Typically, you'll fish for 5 hours in the morning and 3 hours in the afternoon. However, your guide may adjust the schedule depending on the weather, tides, and fish activity.
